K.W.: You hold a PhD in law, working then as an artist is this not a contradiction?

T.B.: Not at all. Working in Law could be Art and for me working in Art is the Law.

K.W.: That's a good closing remark. Thank you for your patience.




Ikarus, 1980 - 2011, Oil / Fujichrome, 11 x 14 inches


